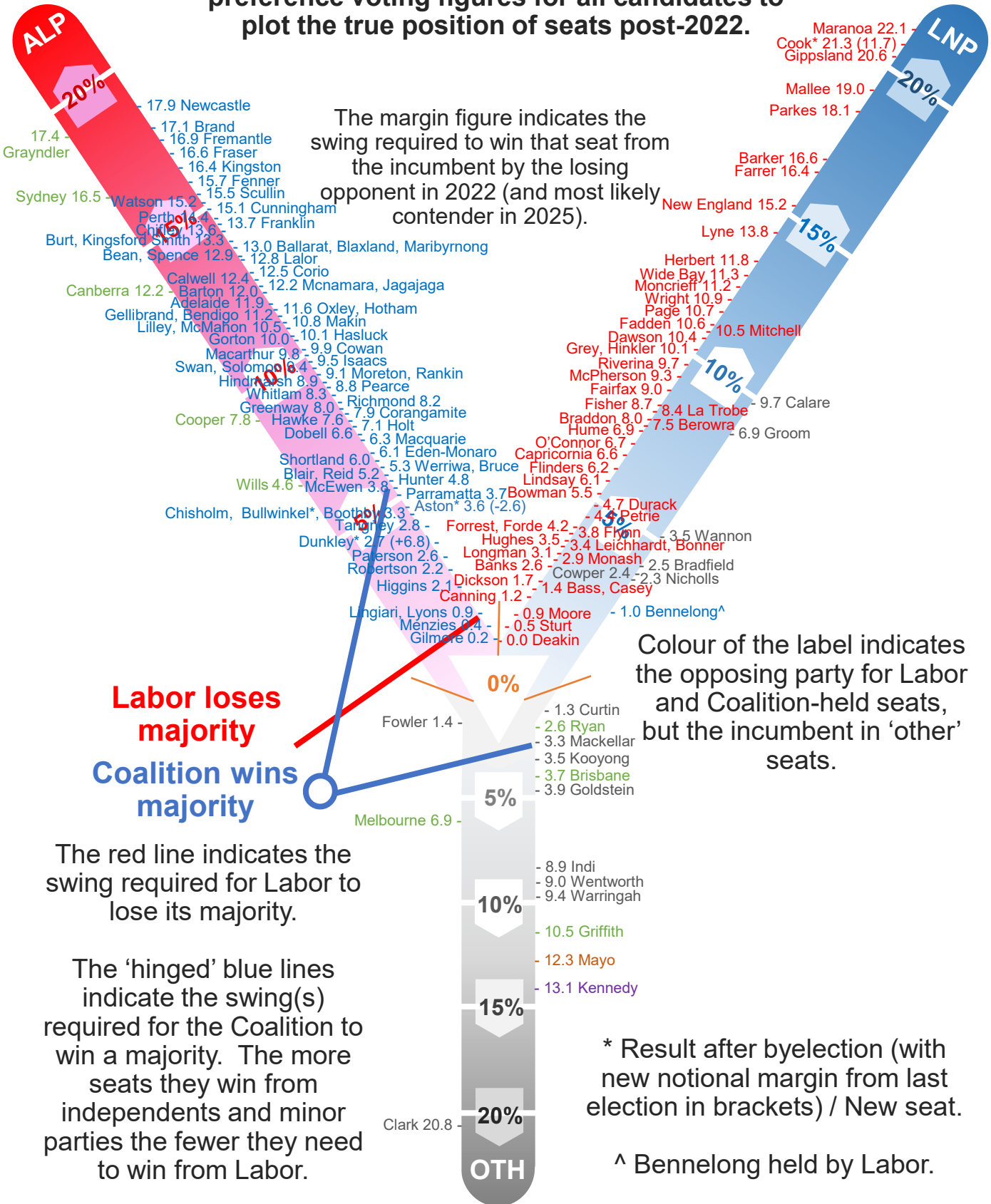


Post-2022 Australian Election Reed Pendulum

This new pendulum uses the two-candidate preference voting figures for all candidates to plot the true position of seats post-2022.

The margin figure indicates the swing required to win that seat from the incumbent by the losing opponent in 2022 (and most likely contender in 2025).



Colour of the label indicates the opposing party for Labor and Coalition-held seats, but the incumbent in 'other' seats.

The red line indicates the swing required for Labor to lose its majority.

The 'hinged' blue lines indicate the swing(s) required for the Coalition to win a majority. The more seats they win from independents and minor parties the fewer they need to win from Labor.
