



Queensland 2024 Vote & Polling Results

This table provides the primary votes after 85% of votes have been counted, compared against the final poll of each pollster. We have omitted polls conducted more than six weeks out, e.g. Redbridge and W+S, as there is strong evidence of a significant narrowing around that time.

Resolve’s poll conducted 1-2 weeks out has performed well again, even looking at data rounded to no decimal places. This included all primary votes (with all parties and candidates named) being within error margins, and the closest TPP vote outcome.

We also congratulate Newspoll and YouGov for being close on many of the measures. In Newspoll’s case, their close primary votes for the major parties may have picked up a movement in the final week, but preference flows appear to have differed from their estimates.

Freshwater’s poll at the start of the campaign was slightly less accurate, but least accurate was the uComms poll, despite it being conducted within 48-hours of the ballot (when many had voted early) and being based on the largest sample size. This continues a pattern for their methodologies.
